IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF ALL PROSPECTIVE PARTICIPANTS:

Computer Camp is for WASD students completing grades 5-7. Remedial Summer School students are ineligible. Your school's PTA may offer a scholarship. Check with the school's PTA for details. It will be the responsibility of the parent to provide transportation for their child to and from the school each day. A light snack will be offered to all participants each day. Please mention any dietary/health concerns.

Week 1: (June 20-24) OR **Week 2:** (June 27-July 1) *Recommended for students entering Grade 6.* Participants will be introduced to our school computer network. Activities include a general introduction to the Windows Operating System, The Print Shop Deluxe©, and Hyperstudio© multimedia software. Students will have the opportunity to make and take a variety of computer-generated items. Introductory Internet use will also be explored. Students who have never attended Computer Camp would be comfortable in this group.

Week 3: (July 11-15) OR **Week 4:** (July 18-22) *Recommended for computer-experienced students entering Grades 6, 7 & 8.* Windows, the Print Shop Deluxe© and Hyperstudio© will be explored at a more advanced level. Power-Using the Windows environment, activities will include the use of graphics & sound recording programs, Internet search engines, project design and programming in HTML will be explored. Multimedia and more advanced computer concepts will be featured. Digital devices and animation will also be included

Week 5: (July 25-29) *Will only be available if enrollment requires opening another week.*

Enrollment is on a first-come first-served basis, limited to 16 students per week. The above groupings are suggested for these dates to allow the enrichment activities; weekly groupings are subject to change as enrollment requires. All students are encouraged to advance their own computer skills and abilities, regardless of grade level or grouping. Students in all sessions will be able to explore our extensive computer software library. If enrollment exceeds 12 students and is enough to form another group, a fifth week may be offered from July 25-29.
